ANIMALS

VERTEBRATES

These animals have a backbone



REPTILES

Their skin is scaly.
They lay eggs.
Their blood is cold



FISH

They have scales. They
have gills to breathe.
They lay eggs, and
their blood is cold



AMPHIBIANS

Their skin is moist
and slimy. They lay
eggs in water.
Their blood is cold



BIRDS

They have feathers
and wings. They lay
eggs, and have beaks.
Their blood is warm



MAMMALS

They have fur or
hair. They milk their
babies. They have
warm blood

INVERTEBRATES

These animals do not have a backbone



COELENTERATES

They have soft
bodies, and
stinging cells



ANNELID WORMS

Their bodies are
segmented



ECHINODERMS

They are spiny
sea creatures



MOLLUSCS

They have soft bodies.
Most have shells

ARTHROPODS

They have a hard
external skeleton
and jointed limbs



ARACHNIDS

They have eight legs,
two body parts,
and NO antennae



CRUSTACEANS

Most are
sea creatures.
They have many legs,
and antennae



INSECTS

They have six legs,
three body parts,
and antennae.
Some have wings



MYRIAPODS

They have many legs
and body segments
