



## **AN INTERVIEW WITH JOHN LOVETT**

### **TRANSCRIPT**

**What's the best moment you have ever lived with Chelsea?**

I have two moments I can remember. The first, winning the Premier League in 2005 and being part of the atmosphere and the second, Munich, 2012, winning the Champions League.

My worst moment with Chelsea would be the Champions League Final in Moscow 2008 against Manchester United. John Terry missed the penalty, Manchester United won the Cup.
