

AN INTERVIEW WITH KERRY TRANSCRIPT

What is your connection with NYC?

Well, my paternal grandparents emigrated from Ireland to New York City in the early 1900s and then my dad was born in the Bronx and I later spent a year living in New York.

How old were you when you moved to NYC?

My favorite place would be Central Park.

What is your favourite attraction in NYC?

My favorite attraction would be the top of the Empire State Building because it's a great place to see the entire city.

What is your favourite museum in NYC?

My favorite museum would be the MoMA, the Museum of Modern Art in New York City.

What is your favourite place outside NYC?

My favorite place outside NYC is New Jersey. It's just across the river and it takes you about 20-30 minutes to get there.

Who is your favourite actor from NYC?

My favorite actor is Robert De Niro. I think he's one of the best actors in the industry right now and I specially love him in films like *Goodfellas* and *A Bronx Tale*.

What is the weather like in NYC?

The weather in general is, well, it's quite typical in the States.
