- 1. Children go to school on public holidays in the USA. **F-Banks and schools are closed on public holidays.**
- 2. Some celebrations in the USA come from other countries. **T–They come from the rich ethnic heritage of the USA, so many come from other countries.**
- 3. Martin Luther King Jr was killed in New York. F-He was killed in Memphis at the Lorraine Motel in 1968.
- 4. Martin Luther King Jr Day is celebrated in January. **T–It is celebrated on the third Monday of January.**
- 5. Abraham Lincoln was the first American president. **F-George Washington was the first**American president.
- 6. The Lincoln Memorial is in the capital, Washington D.C. **T–It is one of the monuments** to visit in the capital.
- 7. Independence Day is the same as the 'Fourth of July.' **T–The Declaration of Independence was signed on the 4th of July.**
- 8. Banks are open on Halloween. **T–Halloween is not a public holiday.**
- 9. Adults go 'trick-or-treating' on Halloween. . F-Children usually go 'trick or treating'.
- 10. The President of the USA is responsible for killing a turkey at Thanksgiving. **F-Every** year he pardons a turkey.
