3. Martin Luther King Jr was killed in New York. **F-He was killed in Memphis at the Lorraine Motel in 1968.**
4. Martin Luther King Jr Day is celebrated in January. **T-It is celebrated on the third Monday of January.**
5. Abraham Lincoln was the first American president. **F-George Washington was the first American president.**
6. The Lincoln Memorial is in the capital, Washington D.C. **T-It is one of the monuments to visit in the capital.**
7. Independence Day is the same as the 'Fourth of July.' **T-The Declaration of Independence was signed on the 4th of July.**
8. Banks are open on Halloween. **T-Halloween is not a public holiday.**
9. Adults go 'trick-or-treating' on Halloween. **F-Children usually go 'trick or treating'.**
10. The President of the USA is responsible for killing a turkey at Thanksgiving. **F-Every year he pardons a turkey.**
