SAN FRANCISCO

HISTORICAL FACTS

- San Francisco is a city in north California with a population of almost 1 million.
- It was founded on June 29, 1776 by colonists from Spain.
- In 1849, the city began to grow because of the Gold Rush.
- In 1906, three-quarters of the city was destroyed by the 1906 earthquake and fire.
- In the sixties, San Francisco became the home for the hippie movement.
- The city has also been the home for the Summer of Love and the gay right movements.

TOP PLACES TO VISIT & THINGS TO DO

- Go up and down San Francisco's steep rolling hills.
- Get on board San Francisco cable cars.
- Buy your tickets for the legendary Alcatraz prison, also known as The Rock.
- Visit its Chinatown district, one of the largest in the world.
- Watch the famous sea lions at Pier 39.
- And, of course, you can't leave San Francisco without visiting the most famous bridge in the world: THE GOLDEN GATE.

LOS ANGELES

HISTORICAL FACTS

- Los Angeles is the second-most populous city in the United States, after New York City, with a population of 3.98 million.
- The city was officially founded by Spain on September 4, 1781.
- It became a part of Mexico in 1821 following the Mexican War of Independence.
- In 1848, it became a part of the United States.
- Los Angeles hosted the 1932 and 1984 Summer Olympics and will host the event for a third time in 2028.
- Los Angeles is famous for its warm weather and movie industry.

TOP PLACES TO VISIT & THINGS TO DO

- Visit the Griffith Observatory, with great views of the city and the Hollywood Sign.
- In Hollywood, visit the Dolby Theatre, where the Oscars Ceremony is held every year and walk along the Walk of Fame.
- On the coast, don't miss Venice Beach, with its canals and the famous outdoor gym where Arnold Schwarzenegger used to train.
- Take a tour to see celebrity homes in Beverly Hills.

LAS VEGAS

- The City of Las Vegas is the largest city in the state of Nevada.
- It is known for its casinos, gambling, shopping, entertainment, and nightlife.

TOP PLACES TO VISIT & THINGS TO DO

- Walk along The Strip, the long avenue with a lot of hotels and casinos on both sides.
- Enjoy thematic hotels like Caesar's Palace, The Venetian or New York New York.
- Watch the Bellagio Fountain show.
- Go by car, coach or plane to the Grand Canyon National Park, one of the world's natural wonders.
