Can he / she / it? ----> **SHORT ANSWERS: Affirmative:** Yes, he / she / it can. **Negative:** No, he / she / it can't.

Can we ----> SHORT ANSWERS: Affirmative: Yes, you can. Negative: No, you can't.

Can you? ----> SHORT ANSWERS: Affirmative: Yes, we can. Negative: No, we can't.

Can they? ----> SHORT ANSWERS: Affirmative: Yes, they can. Negative: No, they can't.
