TELLING THE TIME:

What time is it?

It's ...

ANALOG CLOCK:

- O'clock (en punto) ----> It's eight o'clock.
- A quarter past (e cuarto) ----> It's a quarter past eight.
- Half past (e media) ----> It's half past eight.
- A quarter to (menos cuarto) ----> It's a quarter to nine.

When the minutes past from 0 to 30, we say 'past'... Example: It's twelve past eight (8:12).

When the minutes past from 31 to 59, we say 'to'... *Example: It's twenty-five to nine (8:35).*

DIGITAL CLOCK:

We read the hours and the minutes. If the minutes are something less than ten, we add 'oh' in the place of the zero. *Example: 8:06 It's eight oh six.*

7:00 It's seven o'clock.

7:15 It's seven fifteen.
